### New Dolphin Park Update

Fold Ireland have received notification to grant planning from Dublin City Council planners to built a new facility to replace the current older persons housing in Dolphin Park. This will consist of a two and four story building which will include 41 one bedroom apartments and 1 two bedroom apartment as well as a community facility at ground level. The housing association will now be progressing to the tendering stage with the expectation that works on the building will commence in the Spring of 2017. ### **Regeneration Phase I**

Since the 17th October Purcell Construction have been preparing the site for the construction of the 100 new homes in Phase I. This has included the erection of hoarding and fencing to secure the site, the creation of a new traffic entrance and pedestrian on to Dolphin's Barn as well as the relocation of underground services and the stripping of existing blocks.
