


Community Centre Roof

Dolphin Regeneration UPDATE

Purcell Construction have been appointed by Dublin City Council to build the 100 new homes in Phase I over the next 18 months. Purcell will commence on the 17th October by erecting a hoarding around the site. This will include a new pedestrian entrance onto Dolphin's Barn close to the Tesco store. If you
